**Head Lice**

**Cool Milk**

As of Monday, the school will be offering milk free at morning break for all children under 5 years old. Children over 5 also have the opportunity to have milk, however this does have to be paid for. We have sent a flier home today which explains how you register online and make payment online. Please note we will not accept payment at school for milk, it is managed directly with the cool milk scheme. School hands out the milk to the children based on the list which Cool Milk provides.

Children under 5 have been pre-registered and will automatically receive the milk if they wish to drink it.
