The Year 6 SATs have to be carried out under very strict conditions; papers are then collected for marking externally and returned to school in July. All other assessments are marked internally. The local authority carries out moderating visits to ensure that we are abiding by the Department for Education guidance. Please ensure all Year 6 children are in school and on time each day next week unless seriously ill.

We wish all our children doing assessments over the next two weeks to stay calm and positive. We know they will all try their hardest and we celebrate not just their academic achievements but also their progress in becoming responsible, caring young people.
