Answer Sheet

Remember, (M) is written next to those questions you should have tried to solve mentally first. (W) means a written method is usually more efficient for this question.

1. $\frac{3}{5} + \frac{4}{5} + \frac{2}{5} = \frac{9}{5}$ **or** $1\frac{4}{5}$ (M)

2. $3 \times 7 \times 2 = \mathbf{42}$ (M)

3. $857 + 14,894 = \mathbf{15,751}$ (W)

4. $600 + 500 + 100 = \mathbf{1,200}$ (M)

5. $759 \times 7 = \mathbf{5,313}$ (W)
