


Answer Sheet

Remember, (M) is written next to those questions you should have tried to solve mentally first. (W) means a written method is usually more efficient for this question.

1. $347 \times 6 = \mathbf{2,082}$ (W)

2. $67 \times 23 = \mathbf{1,541}$ (W)

3. $\frac{1}{8} + \frac{6}{8} = \frac{\mathbf{7}}{\mathbf{8}}$ (M)

4. $11 \times 25 = \mathbf{275}$ (M)

5. $\frac{2}{5} \times 3 = \frac{\mathbf{6}}{\mathbf{5}}$ or $\mathbf{1\frac{1}{5}}$ (M)
