No dogs are allowed on site at any time.

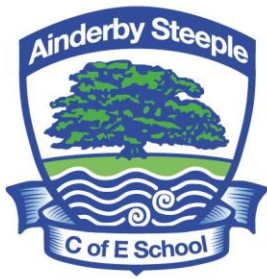
