Little Wandle - Phonics

A new validated Phonic Scheme will be introduced in September. The chosen scheme that will be introduced is Little Wandle Letters and Sounds Revised. The scheme will be delivered predominantly in Early Years and Year 1. However, children in KS2 will also access this scheme if they require phonic intervention. All teaching staff will receive training so that they are fully supported in the delivery of phonic teaching and the use this scheme with fidelity. Parental phonic training will also be delivered to the parents and carers of pupils in Early Years and Year 1. This will be delivered in September. Although this is not compulsory, it would be wonderful for parents to attend as this will give you detailed knowledge of the new phonic scheme, phonics, Early Reading and how you can support your child in the home. **Phonic Training Parents – Wednesday 14th September**

Supporting your child with Reading - Early Years/Key Stage 1

Although your child will be taught to read at school, you can have a huge impact on their reading journey by continuing their practice at home. From September, there will be two types of reading book that your child will bring home:

A Reading Practice Book

This will be at the correct phonic stage for your child. They should be able to read this fluently and independently. This book will be carefully matched to your child's current reading level. If your child is reading it with little help, please don't worry that it's too easy – your child needs to develop fluency and confidence in reading. Listen to your child read the book. Remember to give them lots of praise – celebrate their success! If they can't read a word, read it to them. After they have finished, talk about the book together

Reading for Pleasure Book

Your child will be able to select and bring home a reading for pleasure book. They may not be able to read this on their own. This book is for you both to read and enjoy together. In order to encourage your child to become a lifelong reader, it is important that they learn to read for pleasure. The reading for pleasure book is a book that your child has chosen for you to enjoy together. Please remember that you shouldn't expect your child to read this alone. Read it to or with them. Discuss the pictures, enjoy the story, predict what might happen next, use different voices for the characters, explore the facts in a non-fiction book. The main thing is that you have fun!

Key Stage 2

Your child will continue to access the school reading scheme. In addition to this they will select a Reading for Pleasure Book from the school library.

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Warm Weather

The children are enjoying playtime in this wonderful weather. Please can I remind you to ensure to send a water bottle/water for your child to access in school; pupils are able to replenish their water across the school day. Sun hats and caps are also welcomed and children are encouraged to wear these during playtimes to provide sun protection. Please apply sun cream to your child or support your older child with this process prior to the school day. Thank you.

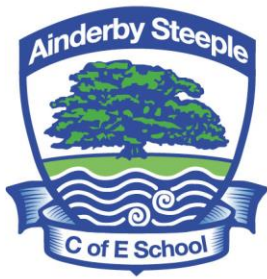
